



2020 SWIMJAMAICA SPRINT MEET`

ASAJ SANCTION #: 20001

VENUE: National Aquatic Centre Pool
Electronic Timing and Hy-Tek Meet Manager will be used

DATES & TIMES: Saturday March 14, 2020
8:30 a.m. Session 1
3:30 p.m. Session 2

Pool will be open 1½ hours before starting time.

ELIGIBILITY: All Clubs and Swimmers registered with the ASAJ or other FINA affiliated Federations.
Age Group Swimming - Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight Dec 31, 2019.
Masters Swimming - Ages for the meet shall be as of midnight Dec 31, 2020.

ENTRY LIMITS: Number of events per swimmer - 2 individual events in each session. No limit on relays
Number of teams per relay event - No limit but only TWO will score
Number of entries per club in 100 M 11 & Over events – 4 entries (see Additional Rule 4.2)

Only swimmers pre-registered in the meet will be allowed to swim relays

Session lengths will be **planned** no longer than 4 hours long. Using FINA points as a guide, slower heats, beginning with the 100 M events, may be eliminated to stay within this time limit. Clubs will be notified on Tuesday March 10, 2020 if any heats have been eliminated.

ENTRY FEES: **HY-TEK ENTRIES**
J\$350.00 for ASAJ registered swimmers or US\$2.50 per individual event for teams submitting their entries using Hy-Tek software.
J\$500.00 (US\$4.00) per relay event for teams submitting their entries using Hy-Tek software
J\$500 per swimmer surcharge.

OTHER ENTRIES
J\$500.00 for ASAJ Registered swimmers or US\$3.50 per event for manual entries and late entries.
J\$600.00 (US\$5.00) per relay event for teams submitting their entries without Hy-Tek software.

LATE ENTRIES
\$2,500 penalty for entries submitted late and/or without the names of the clubs volunteers, unless prior approval has been obtained.

LATE PAYMENT
Swimmers who have not paid the entry fees prior to the start of the meet may not be allowed to participate.

RULES: FINA rules and ASAJ By-laws in force at time of competition will apply. Additional Rules and Regulations are below.

REGISTRATION: The ASAJ Register closes at **4:00 PM on Friday February 21, 2020**

ENTRY DEADLINE: **4:00 PM Friday February 28, 2020.** Entries are preferred in electronic form using Hy-Tek software and emailed to info@swimjamaica.com
Note: Entries will not be accepted without the names of the clubs volunteers (see rule 1.3)

ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. False starts – The FINA starting rules (SW4) will apply.
- 1.2. Passes will be provided for officials, coaches and competitors.
- 1.3. ~~Local clubs are required to submit, with their entries, a list of volunteers to act as Technical Officials and to perform other duties essential to the smooth running of the competition. Volunteers MUST report to the volunteer desk at least 60 minutes before the start of the competition for registration and assignment. Clubs are expected to provide the following minimum number of volunteers (non-compliant clubs will be excluded from participation):~~
 - ~~❖ 1 – 10 swimmers entered: One (1) volunteer per session~~
 - ~~❖ 11 – 20 swimmers entered: Four (4) volunteers per session~~
 - ~~❖ 21 – 40 swimmers entered: Six (6) volunteers per session~~
 - ~~❖ 41 or more swimmers entered: Eight (8) volunteers per session~~

2. **DECK ENTRIES AND TIME TRIALS** will be allowed at the discretion of the Referee. Swim times will be included in the final results but will not score points nor be eligible for awards. A fee of JA\$600.00 per event will be charged. Consideration for deck entries will apply based on the following conditions:

- 2.1. The Request MUST be made at the start of the session for which it applies
- 2.2. Selection is based on a first come basis subject to availability of lane(s)

3. MARSHALLING

- 3.1. There will be no marshalling area for the meet. Swimmers for the next heat must be behind the blocks while the current heat is in progress.
- 3.2. Coaches are responsible to get their swimmers to the starting block. It is the responsibility of the swimmer to swim in the correct lane and heat assigned. If a swimmer swims in the wrong lane or heat, he/she will be automatically disqualified.
- 3.3. Once the starter has taken control of the race (after second whistle), no swimmer may then enter the race. Violation of this rule will result in summary disqualification.

4. ENTRIES

- 4.1. Providing the entries are received before the entry deadline, clubs will be emailed their Hy-Tek MM Entries Report no later than 1 pm on Wednesday March 4, 2020. Corrections shall be submitted, in writing, no later than 1 pm on Monday March 9, 2020.
- 4.2. The psych sheet is scheduled be published by 1 pm on March 11, 2020.
- 4.3. Competitors will only be allowed to swim in their age groups. Masters may enter 13 & Over and Open Relays
- 4.4. To comply with the 4-hour session length, Meet Management may limit the 100 M 11 & Over events to three (3) heats and, if necessary, scratch slower heats in other events. 100 M 11 and Over entries must include proof of time after March 31, 2019.
- 4.5. Scratches are allowed at any time before the starter takes control of the race
- 4.6. Masters records will be entered according to the FINA Masters Age Groups.
- 4.7. Swimmers must be 11 or Over to enter OPEN relays
- 4.8. Mixed relays will comprise two (2) females and two (2) males swimming in any order.

5. AWARDS AND POINTS

- 5.1. Points will be awarded as follows: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 for individual events.
- 5.2. Relay points will be allocated 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2
- 5.3. 11 & Over and 13 & Over events will be scored in the age groups: 11-12, 13-14 and 15 & Over
- 5.4. Masters swimming will be scored in the following age groups: 25-34, 35-44, 45-54 etc.
- 5.5. Masters points will not contribute to the overall team score.
- 5.6. Team trophies (combined age-group and masters) will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place clubs.
- 5.7. Mystery awards will be presented to the winners of heats selected on a random basis.
